Dear Parent/Guardian,

As we approach the end of the academic year, I would like to thank you most sincerely for all that you have been doing with your children over the past few months during these unprecedented times. We greatly appreciate the support that you have shown to continuing your child's education, despite schools being closed during lockdown.
